- 1) Treat all players, officials, opponents and spectators as you would like to be treated. Intimidation / ridicule or ugly remarks based on race, religion, looks/gender or ability will not be tolerated. ***(Many such comments are actually now illegal).***
- 2) Co-operate with your coaches, team-mates and club officials - when given an instruction carry it out to the best of your ability ***with respect*** to all parties concerned.
- 3) Be on time to training or the game as directed by your coach *(if you can't be on time or be at training let the coaching staff know ASAP)*
- 4) Recognise and respect our club and all of the officials and volunteers within **OUR** club who are giving up their valuable time to help you.
- 5) Inappropriate use of social media sites is not acceptable, comments denigrating other players, officials or members will not be tolerated.
- 6) Be a team player - It's a team game, treat it that way and give 100% effort at all times! Play for your *OWN* enjoyment & to improve your skills.
- 7) Control your temper - verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players doesn't help you or your team. This can result in sanctions from the club or the SFDDC *(South Fremantle District Development Council)*.
- 8) Abide by the rules of AFL Football & never argue with an umpire or other official.

The Committee may punish or penalise any member whose conduct, in the opinion of the Committee, is discreditable or harmful to the culture, character or interests of the Club.
